**Clarinet**

**Scales for Wind Instruments:**

Prepare your chromatic scale slurred full range of the instrument, and your major and melodic minor scales with arpeggios up to 4 sharps and 4 flats if range permits, tongued up and slurred down. All scales will be memorized and performed in 16th notes at a minimum tempo of quarter note = 60. You will be asked to play one major and/or one minor scale with arpeggios.
